Just a quick reminder: wristbands are required at all times while using the pool. If you don't have yours, you'll be asked to leave the area—this helps ensure the pool stays reserved for our residents.

Each unit receives one pool pass per leaseholder and two guest passes.

How to stay cool?

- Close blinds/curtains during the day to block out heat.
- Use fans to circulate air—ceiling fans should spin counterclockwise.
- Avoid using the oven during the day—try nocook or microwave meals.

- Use light bedding to sleep cooler at night.
- Turn off lights & electronics when not in use to reduce heat.


